SUBJECT: Entry-Level Compliance Agent Training Sessions for Eligible Locksmiths

Due to the immediate need for compliance agent certification for applicant locksmith businesses coming under regulation as a new category of private security services, we are conducting several dedicated sessions specifically for eligible locksmiths. The regulations require any licensed private security business to designate at least one (1) certified compliance agent to ensure compliance. Individuals seeking this certification must meet eligibility requirements and successfully complete the training and written exam.

Ordinarily the enrollment application must be received in advance of the training session. However, due to the time constraints for locksmith businesses to become licensed, we are offering eligible locksmiths the opportunity to enroll for a session without our receiving the application in advance. **There are several important stipulations:**

- 3. Bring your completed compliance agent certification application (pss_ca) with official third-party documentation of experience attached, fingerprint application (pss-fp) and fingerprint card, and all applicable, non-refundable fees (checks only) with you to the session.
- 4. Once enrolled, you must contact me at least 2 business days prior to the session in order to cancel or reschedule. Failure to attend without canceling in advance will result in your being charge for the class (\$100.00 fee) and having to reapply.
