Three Days of Door Hardware Training

Course Description

This flexible educational program provides students the opportunity to learn about the various types of door hardware servicing at their own pace. Each class is open to students who have completed the basic locksmithing class or have equivalent experience. Students are welcome to take all three days as a package, or just take the specific class(es) that they want. Students with specialized door hardware problems are encouraged to bring them class. Students who drive in are encouraged to bring their own tools. Tools will be provided for working in the classroom.

Sunday, September 20, 2009 –

B008 Servicing Aluminum Storefront Doors 8 hours CE credit

Learn about aluminum storefront doors and frames, and their unique hardware. Door/frame construction, locks, closers, pivots, and other hardware will be presented with an emphasis on installation, servicing, adjustments, and retrofitting techniques.

Improving security on these doors will also be discussed. Some hands-on will be involved. Although handouts are included in the class, students will have the option of purchasing the **Aluminum Stile Door Service & Repair Manual** by Jake Jakubowski for a special reduced price of **\$125.00**. Prerequisite: Basic Locksmithing.

Monday, September 21, 2009 –

B009 Complete Door and Door Closers (P) L-05 8 hours CE credit

“Open the doors” to a new area for your locksmith business. If you have ever wanted to be able to service more than just the locks on a door, then be sure not to miss this class.

You will become familiar with the principles of door closers with emphasis on the selection, adjustment, and installation procedures for non-handed (reversible) surface-mounted door closers. In addition, you will learn about the functions, installation and servicing of door closers, hinges, and related door hardware. The hardware covered will be of commercial or heavy-duty grade. Other types of closers will also be discussed as an aid in preparing for the PRP section on door closers. Although handouts are included in the class, students will have the option of purchasing the **Total Door Service and Repair Manual** by Jake Jakubowski for a special reduced price of **\$100.00**. Prerequisite: Basic Locksmithing. *The information presented will be useful in preparing for PRP section L-00, L-05 and L-41. ALOA Members may take PRP exam Section L-05 at the end of the class for no additional charge.*

Tuesday, September 22, 2009 –

B010 Exit Devices & Exit Alarms (P) L-16 8 hours CE credit

This class has been updated to include delayed exit devices that comply with NFPA101. A wealth of information will be covered on exit devices including: types, functions, ratings, options, installations, repairs and servicing. Hands-on practice as well as slides, videos and handouts will be provided. Students will be able to properly remove, service, troubleshoot malfunctions and retrofit many of the popular exit devices.

Prerequisite: Basic Locksmithing. *The information presented will be useful in preparing for PRP Section L-16. ALOA Members may take PRP Section L-16 at the end of the class for no additional charge.*

Students Receive:

An ACE Certificate attesting **8 credit hours** of CE instruction for each day.

One point toward ALOA PRP re-certification for each day of class attendance.
